## HOW TO GET THERE

**Parramatta is within easy reach of the Sydney CBD, with regular bus, train, ferry and road networks.**

### BY TRAIN

Parramatta has rail links from most major suburban centres in Sydney with just a 30 minute service from Sydney CBD.

### BY BUS

Parramatta is well served by local buses which all use the Interchange on Argyle Street, just around the corner from the outdoor stage at Parramasala.

Once in Parramatta, the best way to move around the city is to catch the Parramatta City Council's free city bus.

### FERRY

The River Express travels between Circular Quay and Parramatta Wharf every day between 7am and 7pm. It takes 50 minutes and arrives at Charles Street in Parramatta CBD.

### BY CAR

Parramatta is 24km from central Sydney with good road connections including Parramatta Road, Victoria Road, and M4 Motorway. From Western Sydney take the Great Western Highway, M4, Old Windsor Road, Woodville Road or Cumberland Highway.

### CAR PARKS

Lennox Bridge, David Frater and Erby Place car parks are all on Phillip Street just moments from Church Street. Other car parks includes Horwood Place, Hunter Street and Wentworth Street. For details visit the car parking information telephone **1300 889 714**.
